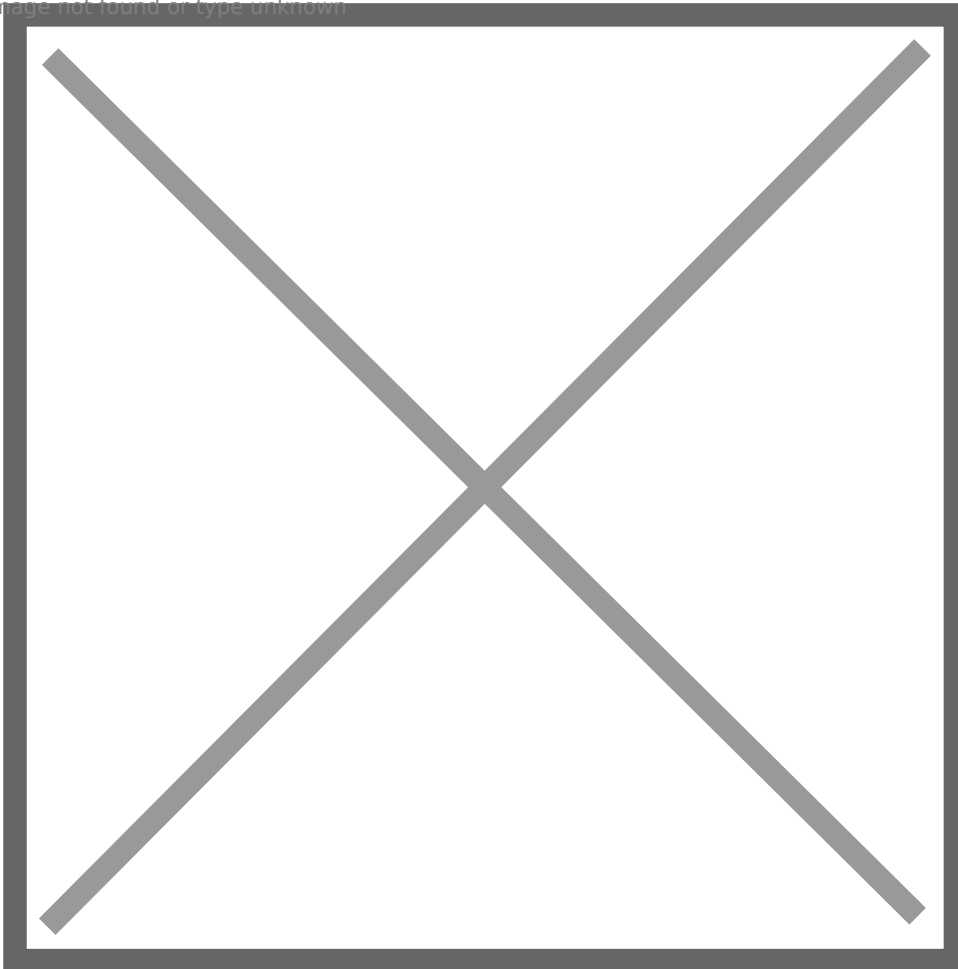
## Overview


**Screen 1: Making an offer**

<b>Title</b>	Title of the offer
<b>Price</b>	Price of services
<b>Price Negotiable</b>	Slide to select whether price is negotiable
<b>Time to Complete (days)</b>	Duration taken to complete the services
<b>Description</b>	Detailed description of the services offered.

### Screen 3: Editing an offer

After you click the required entry that you need to edit, you can change the configurations based on the options as seen in the following table.

<b>Title</b>	Title of the offer made.
<b>Price</b>	Price mentioned by the contractor for the services offered.
<b>Price Negotiable</b>	Enabled if price is negotiable.
<b>Status</b>	Edit status, if required from the following options. By default, every offer made is in the Published state. <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Published</li> <li>Unpublished</li> <li>Trashed</li> <li>Archived</li> </ul>

<b>Offer Status</b>	After reviewing the offer, set the state of the offer to one of the following states. <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Not Accepted (Default status)</li><li>• Accepted</li><li>• Rejected</li></ul>
<b>Time to Complete (days)</b>	Number of days to complete the services required.
<b>ID</b>	Offer ID, which can be used in modules, plugins and menus.
<b>Created by</b>	User name who created the entry.
<b>Description</b>	Description about the serviced offered.
